- 1. Give the customer the complaint form.
- 2. If submitting a written complaint, the CN employee must explain how to complete the complaint form and forward the completed form to the Child Nutrition Director. The CN Director will automatically forward to Texas Department of Agriculture and/or USDA.

If submitting a complaint via email, the complaint and any documentation to TDA by mail, fax, or by emailing a scanned copy.
